



Urgent Call For Action: Save the life of Dr. Elfatih Omer Elsid

On Friday, the 11 of January 2019, Sudanese security forces have arrested Dr. Elfatih Omer Elsid while he was heading out of the mosque after Friday prayers. Dr. Elfatih who is a recovering cancer patient is a prominent member of the Sudan Doctors' Syndicate. He is the general manager of Tuga private hospital in Omdurman. After the announcement that Tuga hospital has opened its doors to treat all the injured protesters in the current Sudanese revolution free of charge, he was swiftly arrested by security forces and held in a yet unknown location. Dr. Elfatih is on vital medication which he has been denied access to so far.



We, in the Sudan Doctors' Syndicate and his family , are extreme concerned about the wellbeing of Dr. Elfatih and call upon the authorities to release him immediately especially given his health condition, along with all other unlawfully incarcerated detainees. We hold the Sudanese government responsible for any harm that may result from Dr. Elfatih's detention. We call on international media and pressure groups to help in the campaign of releasing all detainees.
